It's like a Holy Spirit come over you. My brother-in-law is a Flagboy for Black Feather. By me always hanging around them, going to Indian practice, and sewing for them, they decided they wanted me to be their queen.

They look at how you sew, and if your suit is good, they'll respect you. Everybody has their own style. I'm from the Ninth Ward, but Ninth Ward tribes sew flat. I sew three dimensional, and so I come out in the Seventh Ward. When that Indian music starts—"I'm the Queen, I'm the prettiest Queen you ever seen." I'm gonna bring it to them.
